



Allocations continue to improve in the Murray and Murrumbidgee Valleys

NSW Water Commissioner David Harriss today announced an increase of 5 percent for NSW Murray general security licence holders and an increase of 2 percent for general security licence holders in the Murrumbidgee Valley.

'Today's announcement brings the general security allocation in the NSW Murray to 26 percent of entitlement which, together with carry-over, means that Murray Valley general security users have, on-average, access to 94 percent of entitlement.

"In the Murrumbidgee Valley, the general security allocation has increased by 2 percent to 65 percent of entitlement. This combined with carry-over gives the average Murrumbidgee general security water user access to an equivalent to 92 percent of entitlement," he said.

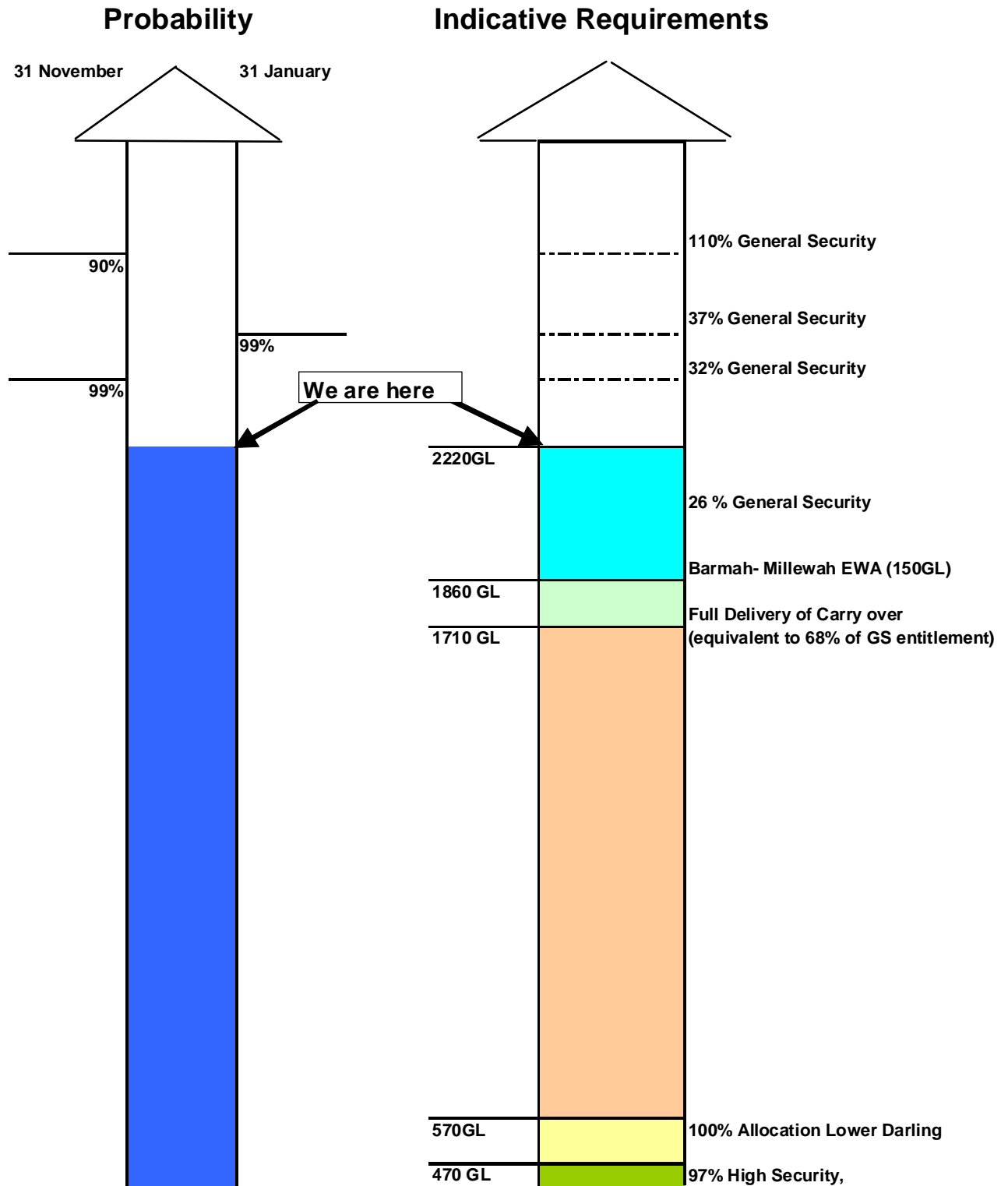
A graphical interpretation of the probabilities for improvement for each valley has been included.

Mr Harriss said that there remains a high probability of allocations reaching 100 percent by December.
