### Increase to water allocations for Bega Brogo licence holders

NSW Water Commissioner David Harriss, today announced a 7 percent increase for general security water users drawing water from the Brogo Dam.

“This increase brings the water allocation for Bega Brogo Valley general security licence holders to 55 percent of entitlement.”

Mr Harriss said that high security licence holders including domestic and stock water users and town water supplies have already received their full allocation of 100 percent.

Brogo Dam is currently full, holding 9,000 megalitres, which has provided sufficient reserves for these allocations.

This announcement will enable water users to plan their activities for the remainder of the year.

The NSW Office of Water will continue to closely monitor rainfall and river inflows and may make subsequent allocation announcements as further water becomes available.
